

1995/262. Permanent forum for indigenous people in the United Nations

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 25 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1995/30 of 3 March 1995:⁶¹

(a) Endorsed the recommendation made by the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities at its forty-sixth session⁶³ that the Centre for Human Rights of the Secretariat organize a workshop on the possible establishment of a permanent forum for indigenous people, with the participation of representatives of Governments, organizations of indigenous people and independent experts;

(b) Recommended that such a workshop be held for a period of three days, within existing resources and in accordance with established United Nations practice, prior to the thirteenth session of the Working Group on Indigenous Populations of the Subcommission and that the outcome of the workshop be transmitted to the Working Group at its thirteenth session.
